

Caroline Judge Fegan TTCT Scholarship 2024

1. Scholarship award details

- One award annually to a music teacher from Britain to attend the Comhaltas Ceoltóirí Eireann residential TTCT diploma course in Dublin.
- 1.2. The scholarship is open to teachers active within Comhaltas who are normally resident in Britain or are a member of Comhaltas in Britain.
- 1.3. Value of Scholarship:
 - 1.3.1. Cost of TTCT course €650
 - 1.3.2. £200 bursary towards travel
- 1.4. TTCT course fee includes accommodation and food at Culturlann na hÉireann, Monkstown Co. Dublin.

2. TTCT course information

2.1. Course Dates for 2024 : Sunday 28th of July– Saturday 3rd of August

3. Scholarship Terms and Condition

- 3.1. Scholarship awardee must be able to attend the course in the year the scholarship is awarded. Attendance cannot be deferred.
- 3.2. Awardee must still meet the requirements of eligibility for the course, including the appropriate amount of teaching experience and the audition/interview.
- 3.3. Audition/interview to establish eligibility for the course will be conducted by CCÉ Dublin in the same procedures as all course attendees.
- 3.4. Award of Scholarship will be determined by the appropriate procedures as outlined and decided by Comhaltas in Britain.
- 3.5. Scholarship applications will be reviewed by a panel and applications will be anonymised before they are provided to the decision panel. Scholarships will be awarded on the strength of the application and CV only.
- 3.6. Individual feedback on the success of scholarship candidates will not be given. Unsuccessful candidates are free to apply again in subsequent years.



- 3.7. The provision of which instruments are being accepted onto the TTCT course in any one particular year will be taken into account.
- 3.8. Awarding of the Scholarship does not guarantee or provide any special mitigations to the awardee in passing the course.
- 3.9. £200 travel bursary will be required to be repaid to Comhaltas in Britain should the scholarship candidate fail to attend the course.
- 3.10. By applying to the scholarship successful awardees greet participation publicity to promote the scholarship and TTCT course including having their name and image published.
- 3.11. Scholarship winners will be required to participate in discussions following the course on their experience, how the scholarship and course has benefitted them as well as their plans for teaching using the knowledge they have learnt.

4. Application Procedure

- 4.1. Prospective nominees should apply to Comhaltas in Britain for the scholarship on the official application form which will be an online form through the www.comhaltas.co.uk website (see appendix 2 for application form). They do not need to complete the TTCT registration on the Comhaltas Ceoltóirí Éireann Website. The scholarship template includes the information required for the TTCT registration.
- 4.2. See Appendix 1 for the 2024 timeline and dates.
- 4.3. The successful awardee will then be passed on to Comhaltas Dublin directly by Comhaltas in Britain for continuation through the audition and registration process.
- 4.4. Potential TTCT candidates who may wish to attend the TTCT course without scholarship (self funded) are free to apply directly to the TTCT course in case they are unsuccessful in being awarded the scholarship. Unsuccessful candidates for the scholarship will be advised of course application procedures when the scholarship award is made.

5. Administration Procedure

5.1. Once the scholarship winner has been confirmed on the course, Comhaltas in Britain will pay the TTCT course fee directly to CCÉ Dublin.



5.2. £200 travel assistance will be transferred to scholarship awardee once they confirm acceptance with signature. Travel receipts will not be required.

6. Equal Opportunities

6.1. Comhaltas in Britain welcomes applications from disabled candidates.
