## Travel to All-Britain Fleadh



**Train:** Brentwood Station is the nearest station. It is on the Elizabeth Line, with direct trains from London Liverpool Street, Stratford, Romford, and central London.

From Brentwood Station:

- 15-minute walk to the school
- or 5-10 minutes by taxi or local bus



**Bus:** Long-distance coaches usually stop in London or Romford. From there, take a train to Brentwood Station. Local buses from Brentwood Station and the town centre stop close to the school (near Council Offices / Seven Arches Road).

Taxis from the station take under 10 minutes.



**Plane:** London Stansted Airport (STN) is the nearest airport.

From Stansted:

1. Take the Stansted Express train to London Liverpool Street.
2. At Liverpool Street, change to the Elizabeth Line towards Shenfield.
3. Get off at Brentwood Station.
4. From Brentwood Station, the school is a 15-minute walk or 5-10 minutes by taxi or bus.

Total journey time is approximately 1 hour 15 minutes.



**Driving Directions:** From the M25: Exit at Junction 28, follow signs for Brentwood (A1023) Continue into Brentwood town centre and follow signs for Seven Arches Road.

From London:

Take the A12 eastbound, exit at Brentwood / M25 Junction 28 then follow A1023 into Brentwood and continue to Seven Arches Road.

From East or North Essex:

Use the A127 or A128 towards Brentwood. Join the A1023 into the town centre and follow signs for Seven Arches Road
